which is aimed at Undergraduate, Basic or Medical Student, Master or PhD students.**



What do you get:

- A reduced congress registration fee of £270 (Same package as standard registration but WMS membership the following year is not included)
- You can apply a maximum of three times over your student career
- You can combine this with a fellowship application as well

What do you need to do:

- Register and submit your abstract in plenty of time before the deadline of 2nd March 2020 (Midnight GMT).
- Follow the strict abstract submission guidelines at: <https://www.wms2020.com/abstracts/>
- During the registration process, upload a letter from your course supervisor confirming you have an ongoing student project and the details (maximum of one side of A4 on headed paper) as part of your submission and a scan of your valid student ID. The letter must confirm you are a Undergraduate, Basic or Medical Student, Master or PhD student. Please note that Post Doc's are not eligible to apply. The letter must ideally be in English. If this is not possible then important key words should be underlined.
- You must submit your abstract within 48 hours of registering, or the place will be released
